Nomination

Home university's outgoing coordinator receives the link to the online nomination and application platform "MobilityOnline" and nominates prospective incoming students.

WINTER SEMESTER: March - 15th April SUMMER SEMESTER: Mid-September – 15th October

When nominating, please refer to our Interinstitutional Agreement. Please be aware that the quantity of students as well as the study programme incoming students are eligible to study at HTW Berlin is regulated by the bilateral exchange agreement.

Promptly after receiving the Letter of Acceptance

Nominated students receive the link to the online nomination and application platform via e-mail and apply at HTW Berlin via "MobilityOnline".

WINTER SEMESTER: Mid-April – 11th May SUMMER SEMESTER:
Mid-October – 11th November

→ HTW sends out Letter of Acceptance to accepted incoming students.

WINTER SEMESTER: End of May SUMMER SEMESTER: End of November
